Dear Dr. Dishner,

Please find attached a proposal to return Young People's Concerts to the Niswonger Performing Arts Center on November 20, 2018. This month, we will send save-the-date emails to constituents and will follow with a postcard and email campaign in August! Themes for 2018 concerts are under development and will be presented to the KSO's Education Advisory Council on May 16, 2018.

I am also enclosing a budget that includes the KSO's actual expenses from November, 2017, and our anticipated expenses for 2018. These numbers include a slight increase in musician costs that make up a majority of our expenses for concerts in Greeneville, a guest artist line item as we do not know who our guest will be at this time, and a stagehand line, as we do not know the production requirements at this time. The sponsorship includes costs for core string and woodwind musicians and per-service woodwind, brass and percussion musicians for the performances in Greeneville. The KSO will cover the remaining cost of core musicians, rehearsals and assume any additional expense for guest artists.

Thank you so much for your continued support of the Knoxville Symphony's educational programs. We are very excited to continue to serve audiences from upper East Tennessee. And thank you for your consideration of this proposal for 2018.

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The Knoxville Symphony Orchestra wishes to bring music to students in upper East Tennessee:

The KSO will present showings of the 2018 Young People's Concert at the Niswonger Performing Arts Center.

Proposed Date: Tuesday, November 20, 2018 Proposed Concerts: 9:30 AM and 11:00 AM

Cost: \$13,260\*\*

Six Young People's Concerts were presented during the 2017-2018 season. Four concerts in Knoxville at the Knoxville Civic Auditorium served 7,477 public, private, and home school students in and around Knox County. Two concerts at the Niswonger Performing Arts Center served an additional 2,216. These concerts included students from the upper East Tennessee school districts: Bristol City, Cocke County, Elizabethton City, Greene County, Greeneville City, Hamblen County, Jefferson County, Kingsport City and Washington County. Themes for the concerts are chosen by the KSO's Education Advisory Council made up of elementary and middle school teachers from the Knox County Public School System, with a meeting scheduled for May 16, 2018.

Young People's Concerts are unique educational programs, designed for students in grades three through five (we invite grades two through seven, believing that they can benefit from the music even if the presentation is not specific to their grade level). All concerts feature young soloists and exciting visual elements to help students stay involved in the presentation. In addition, curriculum materials, including cds and lesson plans are provided for teachers in advance of the concert so that they may prepare their students for the concepts introduced through the live concert experience and so that students may create music with the orchestra through hands-on participation. The concerts will be conducted by the KSO's Music Director, Aram Demirjian.

\*\* As in previous seasons, the above sponsorship amount will allow students to be admitted to the concert free of charge on a first come, first served basis.
